TREASURER'S REPORT – Kim Harding

For the month of September, 2018, on the Statement of Operations, total operating revenue for the month was \$112,171.50 with a variance below budget for the month of \$12,348.09. Current expenses for the month are \$130,683.56 showing a net income of \$11,312.10. On the Reserve and Capital Fund Statement the budgeted reserve allocation for 2018 was pre-paid in January. Allocation to the capital contribution fund was \$3,000.00. Total revenues were \$3,101.55. Expenses for the month were \$45,920.80. Bank accounts and investments are reconciled for the month. As of September 30th, there is an Operations Fund balance of \$904,011.25. The Reserve Accounts have a balance of \$898,886.14.

SECURITY REPORT – Mark Thurn

97 open garage doors reported in September. 6 instances of RV's or trailers parked on the street beyond the 48 hour parking restriction.

For the month there were 35 letters of approval issued, 174 letters of violation, 27 letters of second violation and 0 violation letters rescinded. A total of 3 properties changed hands during the month.
